- The FAA has announced temporary flight-volume reductions of up to 10% at 40 major U.S. airports due to staffing challenges.
- Over 800 cancellations were reported this morning, and more are expected until the shutdown is resolved.
- Airlines are offering added flexibility, including free changes, cancellations, and refunds during this period.
